


Policy Process



1. Academic policies originate within the Academic Senate structure and are sent to the Senate Executive Board. Administrative policies originate through Divisional or cross-Divisional structures and are sent to the PPPC.

- 2. The Clearinghouse determines whether the proposed policy should be considered by the other body. The Clearinghouse also flags policies for meet and confer and sends them to appropriate union representatives.
- 3. Academic Senate and PPPC shape and recommend policy to the President.
- 4. Should different versions of a policy be passed by the Academic Senate and the PPPC, the two versions go to the Clearinghouse. The charge is to facilitate a compromise solution in consultation with appropriate and interested committees for people to take back to each body. (This process iterates until each body has agreed upon a common version of the policy.)
- 5. Policies passed by all appropriate bodies go to the President for approval.
- 6. Policies will use a common numbering system with a prefix.

 Academic Senate policies will have a unique prefix. All policies that go through the Clearinghouse facilitation process will be crosslisted.
