Proposed Name of Minor: Anthropology

The Minor in Anthropology provides students with an introduction to the four fields of anthropology cultural anthropology, bioanthropology, archaeology, and linguistics.

Substantial coursework is offered in Anthropology at every community college in the CSUCI service area, so ANTH 102 and 103 are CAN courses. Anthropology offers a nexus of interdisciplinary training.
